Parent Involvement Plan for Title I

The Washington City Schools believe parent involvement is a vital component of a successful Title program. Parent involvement shall include, but not be limited to, participation by parents in school activities and programs, volunteering in the schools, and by the school providing parents with training and materials to help their child's learning both in the home and the school. The following goals will help to build a partnership between home and school:

Title I staff members will inform parents of the student selection for participation in Title I as well as the reason for the selection.

Title I staff members will conduct annual parent meetings in the district to explain the Title I program. A school day and evening meeting will be scheduled.

Consultation by the Title I staff with parents will be conducted on a regular basis to provide parents with opportunities to make recommendations for changes and improvements in the program such as Parental Involvement Policy and a school wide plan.

School personnel will respond to parent recommendations in a timely manner.

School personnel will provide opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency or with disabilities, including school profiles in a language and form such parents will understand.

The Washington Court House City School District will ensure that parents participate in the design and implementation of the program through selected activities such as providing:

- Parent/Teacher conferences
- Student Progress Reports, distributed on a regular basis
- Parent training through workshops
- Newsletters to parents in a timely manner
- Parents with questionnaires on planning, developing, and operation of the program
- Response to parent recommendations will be provided in a timely manner
- Classroom visitations by parents
- School performance profiles to be shared with parents and explanation of those profiles
- Individual student assessment results will be distributed to parents within a uniform time frame
- Description and explanation of curriculum
- Forms of academic assessment used to measure student progress
- Proficiency levels that students are expected to meet
